FACTS payment options:

#### **Full Payment:**

The entire amount of tuition and fees is paid on or before the first day of school (5% discount). This payment is paid directly to the school office.

#### **Monthly FACTS Payments:**

Tuition is paid over a 12 month period beginning July 1<sup>st</sup> or a 10 month period beginning September 1<sup>st</sup>. The FACTS plan offers two different ways to pay tuition:

1. **Electronic debit**, as authorized by parents, from their bank accounts (checking or savings accounts). It is important to note that FACTS Management Company and Orange County Christian School never see your bank account nor have any direct access to your account. The automatic payment process is strictly controlled by state and federal laws to be completely confidential and limited to what has been authorized by the parents.
2. **Credit cards** (American Express, Discover or MasterCard).
3. **A monthly billing statement** can be mailed home each month giving parents the option of mailing their payment directly to FACTS Tuition Management.

#### **Textbooks:**

OCCS contracts with Back to Books online bookstore. All textbooks will be purchased by parents directly from Back to Books. No book fees will be paid directly to OCCS.

#### **Fundraisers:**

Participation in school's two primary fundraisers is mandatory. Parents may participate or choose to "buy-out." Buy-out options will vary based on each fundraiser.

#### **Miscellaneous Classes:**

Outside vendors may offer classes such as dance, band, karate, etc. which are funded by contract between the parents and the vendors offering services. Informational flyers will be sent home regarding such programs at the beginning of the school term.

### **Other Registration/Tuition Policies:**

**Refunds:** Should circumstances require withdrawal of a student after registration, a refund of 50% of full registration paid shall be made until June 30<sup>th</sup>. After this date, registration fees are non-refundable

**Discount Policy:**

K-12 <sup>th</sup> grade:	Second child:	10% off tuition.
	Third child:	20% off tuition.
	Fourth child:	30% off tuition.
	Preschool Sibling:	\$10.00/week off weekly charge

### **Tuition payments:**

All tuition payments are managed through FACTS Tuition Management Company.

All tuition payments are due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month. Payments received after the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month shall be assessed a late charge of \$30.00, which will be added to the student's account.

### **Daycare Hours and Rates:**

<b>AM—6:00 until 8:00</b>	<b>\$100.00 per month flat rate</b>

(Multiple children in a family: @ sibling is 50% of the normal fee)

### **Christmas and Easter Break rates:**

**Lunches not included**

**\$100.00 per week. (@ Sibling is 50% of the normal fee.)**

**\$25.00 per day**

Students must be signed into and out of daycare each day. Students over the age of 10 may sign themselves into AM daycare, with parent permission, but an adult must sign them out in the evening. For safety and emergency reasons, we must know who is on campus, and who has removed a child from campus.

### **Hot lunch program information:**

After the first week of school, a hot lunch program is available. Students will receive a menu for the upcoming month, and may select the days they will be purchasing a lunch. Cost of lunches is \$4.00 @, with an additional entree item often offered for a small charge if needed for older students who eat more. Milk, chocolate milk, or juice is included, and these drink items are available for fifty cents to students who choose to bring a lunch, as well. Lunches are usually ordered for the month and prepaid, or you may order and prepay by the week.

Orders must be received on Thursday of the week prior to the menu dates, as we must order ahead from our vendors. Be sure to write your student's name and grade on your order sheet! *We are sorry, but we cannot accept late orders, as the foods are pre-ordered on the Friday before they are served. Thank you for your help in seeing that orders are turned in by Thursday of each week.*

Students may purchase breakfast items up until 8:00 AM, and snacks may be purchased at the morning nutrition break/recess, as well as after school from 3:00 until 3:15. Snacks range from 25 cents to a dollar.
