

Camper Information Sheet

We are looking forward to your upcoming visit to Pine Summit. The following information is provided to help make your stay a pleasant one. Please read it carefully.

- **Emergency Phone Number**– After business hours, dial the camp number 909-866-5801 X123 to reach the Guest Host. The Guest Host has a cellular phone with which to answer any emergency calls.
- **Emergency Information**- In case of a national or local emergency, please visit our web site at www.pinesummit.com for updated information on the security and safety of any campers who are presently at Pine Summit.
- **Special Diets**– We will strive to accommodate medical diets. If you have a special health need, please contact the Manager of Food Service, preferably at least two weeks in advance, so we can talk through your needs. The Manager of Food Service can be reached at 909-866-5801 X130.
- **Ropes Courses/Paintball**– These special activities are available to groups from juniors (fourth-sixth graders) through adults, in the spring through fall (weather permitting). These activities are designed so our guests can have fun, learn spiritual truths, and develop greater character. Check with your group leader to see if this is an option with your retreat. There is an additional cost for these activities.

Please help us in the following areas:

- For the safety of everyone, please do not use skateboards, scooters, Razors, rollerblades, or bicycles on the grounds.
- Radios, walkmans and computer games tend to take campers' focus off the camp experience; therefore, we discourage their use.
- No pets are allowed.
- Because of fire danger and as a courtesy to other guests, Pine Summit requests that smoking on our grounds be limited to our designated smoking area by Lot E.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the grounds.

Winter: (With Pine Summit at 7,000 feet, please keep the following suggestions in mind.)

- Have antifreeze in the car or bus radiators.
- Bring chains with expanders. The CHP stresses that all vehicles (including 4WD vehicles) must carry properly fitting chains from November to April regardless of the type of vehicle or conditions posted.
- Your anticipated travel time should take into account unexpected weather conditions.
- You may want to call for road conditions prior to leaving for camp. Cal Trans can be reached at 800-427-7623, or the Big Bear Road and Snow Line can be reached at 909-866-SNOW, or 909-866-ROAD.
- Inner tubes are available for use on the Pine Summit groomed inner tube runs. Checkout requires a photo ID or \$5.00 refundable deposit.
- Skiers are advised to purchase ski lift tickets for Snow Summit or Bear Mountain ski areas prior to your coming. Be sure to do so early and arrange for ski equipment rentals at that time.
