- Blue/black pens
- #2 pencils or mechanical

- Ruler (centimeters/inches)
- Scissors (recommended for projects)
- Tape (recommended)
- Colored Pencils
- Pencil Sharpener (small)
- 3x5 Index cards
- Highlighter
- USB drive
- White out (non-liquid recommended)

- Pencil pouch (for 3-ring binder)
- Protractor (for Pre-Algebra, Algebra 1A, or Geometry)
- Compass (for Pre-Algebra, Algebra 1A, or Geometry)
- Notebook (3-ring binder)
- Folders
- Homework Journal (recommended)*
- Kleenex (recommended)
- Scientific Calculator (for Geometry, Algebra 2, Physical Science, or Chemistry)
- Graphing Calculator (strongly recommended for Precalculus and AP Calculus; minimum requirement is scientific cal.)
- Small binder for English and Reading (6th grade only)

*The homework journal is intended for students to write down daily homework assignments. A planer, spiral notepad or composition book would suffice.

In addition to the supplies needed at school, students will want to make sure they have the necessary supplies (pens, pencils, paper, etc.) at home, as well, to be equipped for homework assignments.

Teachers may require students to get additional supplies for projects and special assignments. Be sure to look for this information from your child's teacher throughout the year!
